Description

An exciting excursion on board a glass-bottomed boat to admire at close quarters the spectacular colours and the wide variety of fish that abound around the coral reef off Freeport.

What we will see:

- Mini-cruise, Freeport coastline, main attractions of the city
- Glass-bottomed boat excursion, coral reef, fish

What we will do:

- We leave for a 20 minute **mini-cruise** along the coast during which we have the opportunity to admire many of the main attractions of **Freeport**, the second most important centre of the Bahamas after the capital city Nassau.
- Our cruise takes us in the direction of a **shallow coral reef** where, thanks to the boat's transparent bottom, **we can admire spectacular views of the seabed in comfort. We are overwhelmed by the bright colours and the wide variety of fish**** that abound around this reef that is so full of life.
- Our tour ends in Port Lucaya where we have some **free time** for **shopping** or to go for a **walk** in the city before taking the shuttle bus back to the ship (shuttle bus runs every half an hour).

What you need to know:
