Get set to spend a little more than half a day exploring the leeward side of Saint Vincent and visiting Wallilabou, the village where at least part of the "Pirates of the Caribbean" films were shot. You'll begin the outing with a scenic 1.5-hour journey, either by coach or by catamaran. On arrival, you can either relax in the sun, cool off in the water or go snorkelling to see some of the colourful marine life found in this region. You'll then continue up to the Dark View Waterfall, a gorgeous cascade that tumbles to a pool about 23 m below. You'll have time for a brief dip in the cool water here as well as to enjoy sandwiches and other tasty goodies. You'll then return to base by catamaran, with great views of the island to savour as you go. Please note: the tour may be run in reverse order and involves travelling on both a catamaran and a coach. Guests will have to cross a short bamboo bridge to reach the Dark View Waterfall. Guests are further recommended to wear comfortable clothing, swimwear and high-factor sunscreen. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for women who are in more than the 7th month of pregnancy and for guests of limited mobility.
